The owners, Ágnes and Albrecht Wirtz, opened the iconic Villa Bagatelle bistro in the neighbouring building 12 years ago. The spot soon became known as one of the best breakfast places in town. The building also houses an artisan confectionery and bakery that produces handmade, high-quality breads and pastries. However, the couple always dreamed of a place where they would book a room to stay in, too. A place where every guest has the feeling they're visiting family members.†

In 2020, this dream came true and the Gardenhouse was opened. As sources of inspiration and harmony, art, nature and literature play an important role in Ágnes and Albrecht's lives. Art is present in many forms in the building. The interior is a nice coexistence

of design furniture, the owners' personal objects, unique, hand-picked accessories, and contemporary ceramics and artwork.

This stylish six-room home-from-home hotel is on the hilly Buda side of Budapest.

All six rooms are of different character and style. Each room is furnished with iconic design furniture combined with accessories made by contemporary Hungarian artists. It's possible to rent the entire villa.

The villa is set amid a peaceful garden where something is always in bloom. The Gardenroom is the public space of the villa; its large glass surfaces make it feel like part of the garden.

Single-use plastics are shunned and the hotel only uses recycled paper to write on or for packaging. Tap water is filtered using a purification system and bottled in-house. The soap in the bathrooms is made only from natural ingredients, and cleaning products are environmentally friendly. Through these small steps, the hotel contribute to a more sustainable and greener future.

The UNESCO World Heritage Site of Buda Castle district is within close range of all the city's important sites, landmark buildings, national monuments, museums and neighbourhoods.

Baltazár Boutique Hotel has 11 individually designed casual, yet luxurious rooms and suites. In the stylish guest rooms, no detail is overlooked; the eclectic nature of the public spaces at Baltazár is carried on into all the rooms and suites.

Each luxury room has its own bohemian spirit featuring an innovative mix of colour, texture, artwork and graphic design. The guest rooms all come appointed with original vintage and modern furnishings and handcrafted local limestone bathrooms, complemented by top-tier amenities and technology. The individually themed rooms, wall colours, wallpapers and artwork feature designs and inspirations by the likes of Vivienne Westwood, Keith Haring, Andy Warhol and Jean-Michel Basquiat.

At Baltazár, there's a strong focus on gastronomy, too. Downstairs from the rooms, there's Baltazár Grill, a vibrant restaurant and bar that's a firm favourite with locals. It features a charcoal grill and an extensive wine selection from the Carpathian Basin. There's gourmet street food, food for sharing, delicious meat dishes and great vegetarian options: simple, yet creative dishes are all part of what characterises Baltazár's lively *Michelin Guide*-recommended kitchen.

The romantic cobble stoned terrace, playful atmosphere, excellent service, outstanding kitchen and exceptional design help make Baltazár unique. The area offers stunning views of the city and the Danube River while also being home to several historic churches, such as the 14th-century Matthias Church.

The neighbourhood of this small luxury hotel is also a key gastronomic quarter of Budapest, with unique and celebrated restaurants such as the 40-year-old elegant Pierrot, 21 Hungarian Kitchen, Pest-Buda Bistro or Jamie Oliver's Italian restaurant.
